### Conditions Of Entry

- **Entries close: Monday 9<sup>th</sup> February, 2009 at 12.00 noon. No late entries will be accepted.**
- Entries to be submitted to: Swimming WA PO Box 205 Leederville WA 6903.
- Payment can be made by cheque or schools can be invoiced.
- The entry fee is \$15.00 (GST inc) per team per event. Entry into events 17 and 18 is free.
- Entries must be submitted on the enclosed entry form. Photocopies will be accepted.
- Schools and Colleges are restricted to enter one team for events 17 and 18.
- Schools and Colleges are welcome to enter more than one team in all other events, and in as many events as they like. **Competitors are restricted to swim in only one freestyle team and one medley relay team (in addition to events 17 & 18). Any swimmer may enter events 17 & 18.**
- Team members must be bona fide students of the School or College they represent.
- An approximate entry time for each team should be indicated.
- Names of swimmers and reserves are not required until the day of the meet. Names must be submitted on Swimming WA relay cards by 8.30am (Primary), 11:00am (Middle) and 1.30pm (Secondary). Relay cards will be posted to schools prior to the meet.
- It is the responsibility of the School or College to have their team marshalled at the correct time, and to ensure that

members are in the correct position for the start and conduct of each relay.

- **Schools are to provide two volunteers to act as officials (eg timekeepers, program sellers).**
- Two complimentary entry passes will be provided to each school.
- Programs may be purchased at the venue on the day.
- Pool entry is as per Challenge Stadium fees.

### Competition Rules

- **Competitors are able to swim up a year group in any event. However, are restricted to swim in one freestyle and one medley team only (in addition to events 17 & 18).**
- Medley relays will be swum in the following order: Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly, Freestyle.
- The primary schools division will adopt modified rules and as such there will be no disqualifications or medallions.
- The middle and secondary school divisions will be in accordance with FINA rules. FINA rules are available at [www.fina.org](http://www.fina.org)
- **A maximum of two teams per school will be seeded in the fastest heat.**

### Points Allocation & Awards

- All events will be conducted as "timed finals". This means that the winner is the team that records the fastest overall time (regardless of the heat they swim in).
- Medallions will be presented to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place teams in each event in the middle and secondary school divisions.
- The Pop Agnew and McClements/Watson Trophies will be presented to the winners of events 17 and 18.
- Champion Schools Cups will be awarded to schools that achieve the highest overall point-score. The Champion School (Boys Events) is based on results of events 9, 11, 13, 15, 19, 21, 23, 25, 27 and 29. The Champion School (Girls Events) is based on the results of events 10, 12, 14, 16, 20, 22, 24, 26, 28 and 30. Points will be awarded as follows: 14, 10, 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. **Results from Events 17 and 18 will not be included in the Champions Schools Cups Award**
