Country Club Membership

WA Swimming Policies 11 & 12

DEFINITION OF A COUNTRY CLUB

A Country Swimming Club shall be any club whose town base falls in line with Local Government Authorities and Towns for Country Regions. This will take effect from 1 May 1998.

Provision will be made for existing members who previously qualified under the 50km radius criteria for Country Clubs who do not meet the above criteria (grandfather clause) however, all new members must meet the above criteria.

DEFINITION OF A COUNTRY SWIMMER

Country Swimmer

A Country Swimmer is a member whose principal place of residence falls in line with DSR Regions, Local Government Authorities and Towns for Country Regions.

Country Students at Metropolitan Schools

Students attending educational institutions in the Perth metropolitan area may have the option of registering with their home country club or a metropolitan club.

Any exception to the above rule will be at the discretion of the Board.

Objective

The objective of this policy is to clearly define Country Clubs and swimmers so that country competitions such as Country Pennants and Country Championships are open only to bona fide country swimmers.

Metropolitan Domiciled Student

Any swimmer permanently domiciled in the metropolitan area, who as a member of a country club, shall be eligible to compete in Country Championships, Country Pennants, and hold Country Records, subject to being a registered member of that club prior to 30th November of that year.

The provision of a second transfer in that season shall not apply to the applicant whatever the circumstance.
