Conditions of Entry

- **This meet is an invitational meet. Only swimmers who have ranked in the top ten (eight swimmers and two reserves) from the combined club Shell Novice Swim Meets will qualify to swim. Swimmers will be notified of their selection to swim in this meet by Swimming WA. Swimmers must register their intent to swim at the carnival prior to May 8th.**
- It is the responsibility of the Swimmer to marshal at the correct time, and to ensure that they are in the correct position for the start of each race.
- **Parents are asked to help as volunteers (e.g. timekeepers, program sellers, runners etc).**
- Programs may be purchased at the venue on the day.
- Pool entry is as per Riverton Leisureplex fees.

Competition Rules

- The meet will be run in accordance with FINA rules. FINA rules are available at www.fina.org. Disqualifications will occur at this meet.
- Reserves are required to marshal for each event.

Awards

- Medallions will be presented to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place swimmer in each event.
- All swimmers who make it through to the Swimming WA Shell Novice Final Swim Meet will receive a Shell Finalist swim cap. Swimmers are required to report to the registration table to collect their cap. **Swimmers can only collect one cap** irrespective of the amount of races they are in.
