



2010 Commonwealth Games Selection Criteria Elite Athletes with Disabilities (EAD)

Competitions	2010 Commonwealth Games New Delhi, India – 3rd to 14th October 2010
Selection Event	2010 Telstra Australian Championships
Eligibility	To be considered for selection, a swimmer must: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) be an Australian citizen who is eligible to represent Australia in the 2010 Commonwealth Games as per FINA General Rule 2 (GR 2) be a registered member of Swimming Australia Ltd. (SAL) in good standing b) sign and comply with the SAL Team By-Laws and Directions c) be available to fulfil the Team Commitments listed below: Staging Camp – Kuala Lumpur (TBC) 22nd – 29th September 2010 d) be able to satisfy SAL that the swimmers classification is correct.
Team Commitments	All swimmers must commit to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) complying with the SAL Team By-Laws and Team Directions, Anti-Doping Policy and Member Protection Policy; b) conform to SAL policy regarding team preparation; c) make themselves available for all team activities designated by SAL.
Performance Requirements	The first three available placegetters with a Multi Class Point Score over 800 points in the final of each of the following events: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Mens S8 100 Freestyle - Mens S9 50 Freestyle - Mens S10 100 Freestyle - Womens S9 50 Freestyle - Womens S9 100 Freestyle - Womens S9 100 Butterfly <p>Meeting the performance requirements for consideration does not guarantee selection.</p>
Team Size	The maximum team size will be 18 swimmers. Athletes will be selected according to the priorities listed above. If a swimmer withdraws from the team, an additional swimmer may be selected.
Rankings	In the case of a tie for a possible position on the team in a given event, a swim off will be conducted in that event at a time to be determined by the National Paralympic Coach and Meet Director.
Note	The Selection Process will be carried out in accordance to SAL General By-Law GBL 4.2. The Board of Swimming Australia may amend these nomination criteria at any time at its discretion.
