<b>Selection Event</b>	<b>2009 Telstra Australian Short Course Swimming Championships, 8-12 August 2009.</b>
<b>Selection Events</b>	<p>S1-13 50m Freestyle          S1-13 100m Freestyle          S1-5 200 Freestyle          S6-13 400m Freestyle          S1-5 50 Backstroke          S6-13 100m Backstroke          SB1-3 50 Breaststroke          SB4-13 100m Breaststroke          S1-7 50 Butterfly          S8-13 100m Butterfly          SM1-4 150 Individual Medley          SM5-13 200m Individual Medley</p>
<b>Eligibility</b>	<p>To be considered for selection, a swimmer must be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) an Australian citizen who is eligible to represent Australia under IPC Swimming Rules.</li> <li>b) a registered member of Swimming Australia Ltd. (SAL) in good standing.</li> <li>c) able to satisfy SAL that the swimmers classification is correct.</li> <li>d) must have an IPC Swimming License or the capacity to obtain one in time to eligible to compete at the 2009 IPC Swimming World Short Course Championships.</li> </ul>
<b>Squad Commitments</b>	<p>All swimmers must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a) comply with the SAL Team By-Laws and Team Directions, Anti-Doping Policy and Member Protection Policy;</li> <li>b) conform to SAL policy regarding team preparation;</li> <li>c) make themselves available for all squad activities designated by the SAL High Performance Committee</li> </ul>
<b>Performance Requirements</b>	<p>Swimmers will be ranked using the Australian Long Course Disability International Point Score (DIPS) and up to 8 highest ranked Male and up to 8 highest ranked Female swimmers will be considered for selection.</p> <p>A maximum of 2 swimmers per event may be selected.</p> <p>In the event of a tie, with two or more athletes on the same DIPS, swimmers will be ranked on their second best performance.</p>
<b>Team Size</b>	There will be a maximum team size of 8 Male and 8 Female swimmers.
<b>Note</b>	The Board of Swimming Australia may amend these selection criteria at any time at its discretion.
<b>Date of Approval</b>	20 June 2009
